### About AIB

The Association of Issuing Bodies (AIB) is an international non-profit organisation aiming to unite the European issuing bodies of energy attribute tracking systems for all energy carriers and technologies.

AIB facilitates European transfers of such certificates by operating a Hub for international transfers of energy certificates between the registries of its members, and aims to bring operational excellence in facilitating the IT infrastructure of the system of guarantees of origin. We strive for harmonisation of rules and practices and operate a quality assurance framework for managing energy certificate systems in Europe. AIB establishes cooperation and exchange of expertise with and between issuing bodies and disclosure bodies, market parties and other stakeholders and transparently provides market activity information and expert information.

### IT Application Officer

We are looking for an all-round, high-energy team player who can both think strategically and supervise IT suppliers, but is not afraid of operational tasks.

More specifically you will:

- Manage the transfer Hub (a message transfer system for internationally exchanging tradable certificates of origin of renewable energy) as SuperUser and supervising releases, user acceptance tests and SLA compliance.
- Manage the Data Management environment (an innovative platform for data analysis, data visualisation and reporting), including perform in-depth data analysis and provide advise based on detected transfer patterns
- Manage the AIB website: CMS and access control of the website
- Be IT-technical lead for the AIB and support the organization with future IT developments: proactively propose development opportunities, collect, realise, and introduce new requirements or system functions that result from the law or are needed for the permanent optimisation of business processes (agile release management)
- Prioritise and process all requests and problem reports in the application area (Incident Management)
- Coordinate Life Cycle Management on AIB systems
- Manage the contract with IT suppliers on a daily basis in close cooperation with the IT contract manager
- Conduct technical audits on member systems for compliancy
- Support the AIB systems unit (ISU) which steers the IT systems for international inter-registry information transfer for energy certificates.
- Support members in using the AIB systems

- Higher IT-technical education or university degree preferably in computer sciences, or the willingness to obtain relevant IT knowledge for the role (certificates)
- 3+ years of professional experience in a corresponding environment, preferably in the energy sector. Solid expertise in incident/ requirements /change /release / and test management processes. Experience in the following domains is an asset: supply chain / energy tracking systems and collaborative software project tools, software architecture, development, experience in an agile environment with larger software projects
- Knowledge/experience SQL (database queries), Python, Power BI essential. Knowledge/experience Rabbitmq, drupal, databricks is beneficial.
- Willingness to deep dive into technology where needed without becoming a specialist.
- Strong conceptual and analytical skills
- Fluency in English (reading, writing, speech) is essential
- Independent, flexible, and able to work under pressure
- Linguistic, communicative, and structured personality
- Open-minded, humourous and proactive team player with assertiveness
- Applicants must already be legally residing in Europe
