




# MARKET NEEDS Simple to describe, challenging to achieve

Market participants have 3 key goals in the revision of CEN 16325:

- 1. A reliable, robust, and generic GO system for all energy carriers that inspires consumer confidence
- 2. Common cancellation rules = ending 'power supplier exclusivity'



## 1. Reliable and robust system = consumer confidence

Many rules and guidelines

Limited time to process all



Need for simple, easily understood administration and well integrated sectors



Confidence in overall system crucial





#### 2. Common cancelation

Some countries have a 'power supplier exclusivity' rule.

Limits market by restricting capacity of brokers/traders to act on clients' behalf.

Goes against consumer choice – the goal of GO systems

Future potential of multi-national cancellations








#### 3. Common deadlines

Different deadlines for cancelation and expiry in different countries



Leads to confusion for consumers

Reduces efficiency for market participants
