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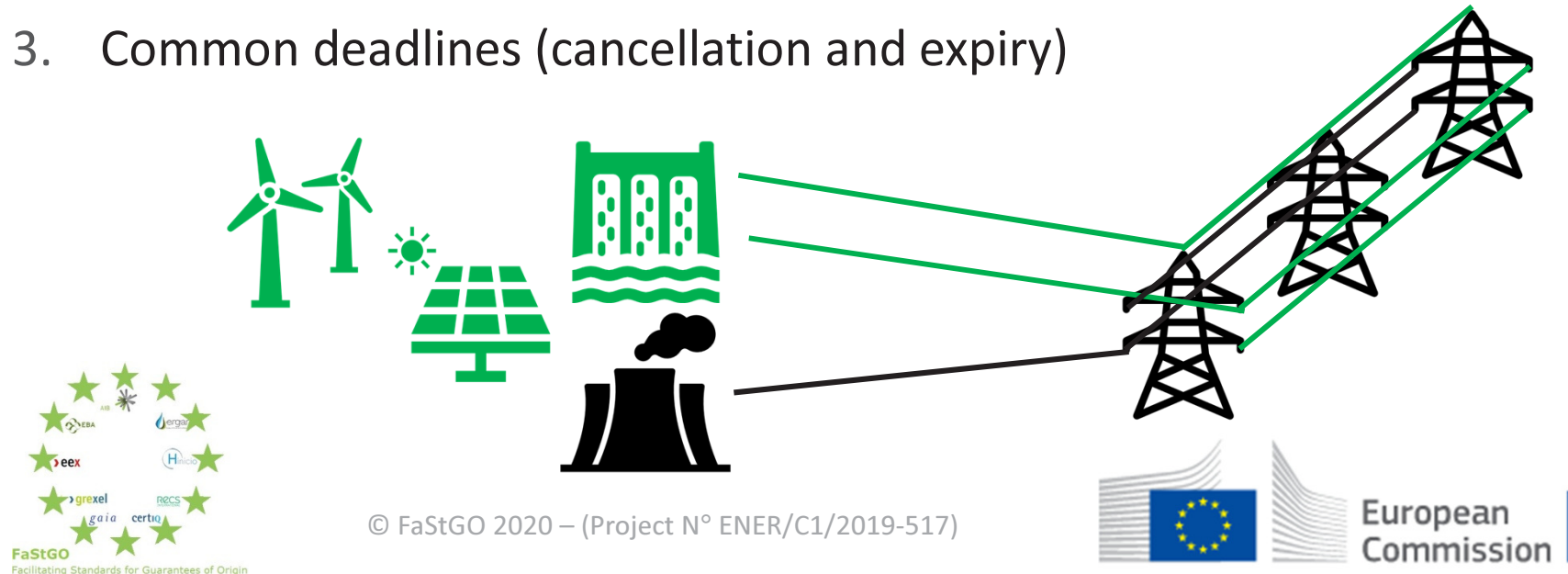


MARKET NEEDS

Simple to describe, challenging to achieve

Market participants have 3 key goals in the revision of CEN 16325:

1. A reliable, robust, and generic GO system for all energy carriers that inspires consumer confidence
2. Common cancellation rules = ending 'power supplier exclusivity'
3. Common deadlines (cancellation and expiry)



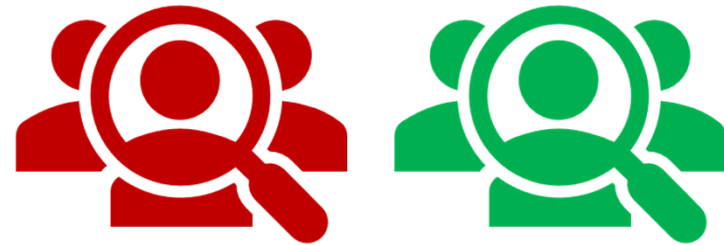
1. Reliable and robust system = consumer confidence

Many rules and guidelines

Limited time to process all

Need for simple, easily understood administration and well integrated sectors

Confidence in overall system crucial



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2. Common cancelation

Some countries have a ‘power supplier exclusivity’ rule.

Limits market by restricting capacity of brokers/traders to act on clients’ behalf.

Goes against consumer choice – the goal of GO systems

Future potential of multi-national cancellations

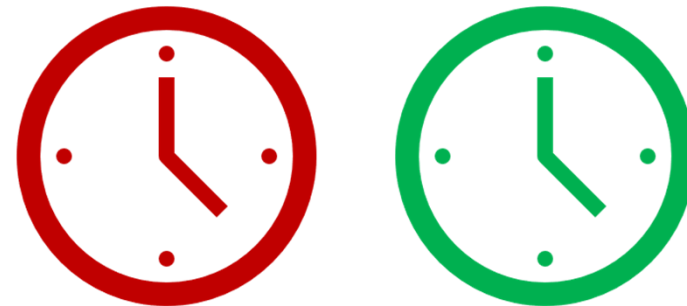


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3. Common deadlines

Different deadlines for cancelation and expiry in different countries



Leads to confusion for consumers

Reduces efficiency for market participants
