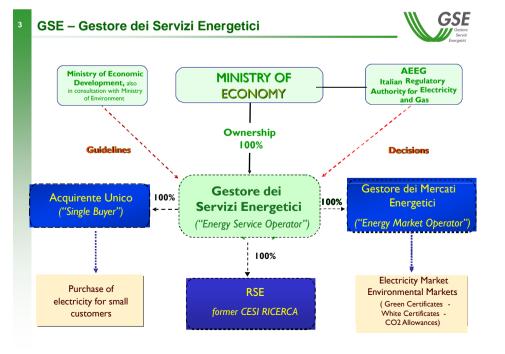

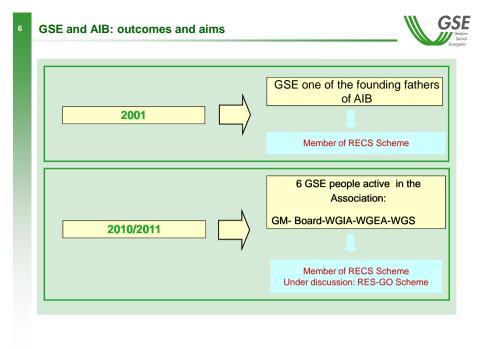


GSE's main activities

- ✓ Qualifying RES-E plants and co-generation plants
- ✓ Issuing Green Certificates and monitoring compliance of producers and importers with the related obligations
- ✓ Issuing the Guarantee of Origin for electricity generated by RES and CHP plants and RECS (Renewable Energy Certificate System) certificates
- ✓ Managing "net-metering system" ("scambio sul posto") for electricity generated by RES plants up to 200 kW or CHP plants
- ✓ Managing support schemes (Feed-in-premium) for electricity generation by PV and thermodynamic solar plants ("Conto Energia")
- Managing and carrying out technical <u>inspections</u> on RES plants
- ✓ Participation within international associations (IEA, OME, AIB)
- Energy Consultancy to Pubblic Administration



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GSE and AIB: outcomes and aims



Which is the additional benefit of joining the AIB?

- ✓ The strong networking action, information exchange
- The possibility to strengthen GO in EU and in National Regulations
- ✓ The common approach to a voluntary certification system

Which are the GSE expectations for 2011?

- Is Under discussion the possibility to join also the RES GO scheme in 2011 on the light of the Italian Ministry Decree (DM 31/07/09)
- ✓ The AIB Certificate requirements are the same as the Decree

Why did GSE focused on RECS?

✓ Because of the market operator request

✓In a lack of clear rules for the "green pricing" RECS has been the FIRST tool attesting the renewable energy production to the consumers

The RECS evolution in Italy

 \checkmark 2002: The market Operator were very active in building rules and framework

✓ 2010: The market Operator are more active in market activities

✓ Almost the 25% of the members are Italian (49 to 251)

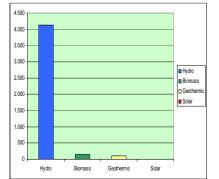

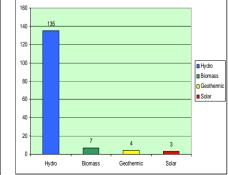


Outcomes of qualification procedure up to 31/12/2009

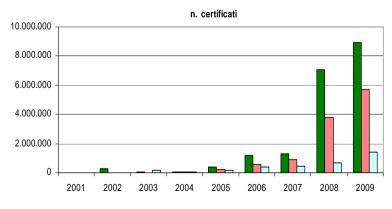
