- Under review of lawyer-linguists
- Art 19 shows clear progress compared to 3<sup>rd</sup> Package
- Some questions remain however:
  - CEN/CENELEC standard EN 16325
  - Art 19(8) – Survey among AIB members
    - Changes to RM?
    - Treatment of imports?
- Better governance of the process chain from issuing GOs to use for disclosure information

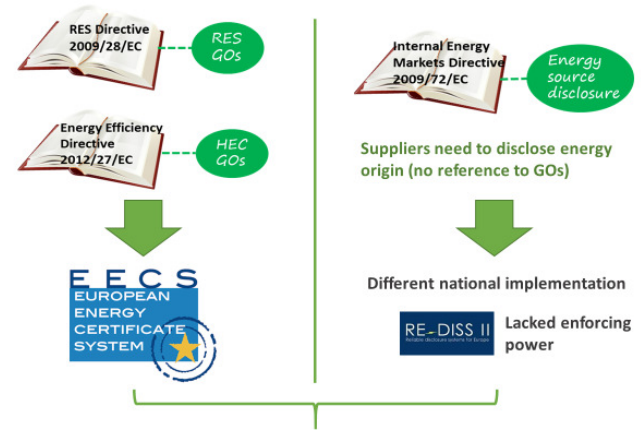

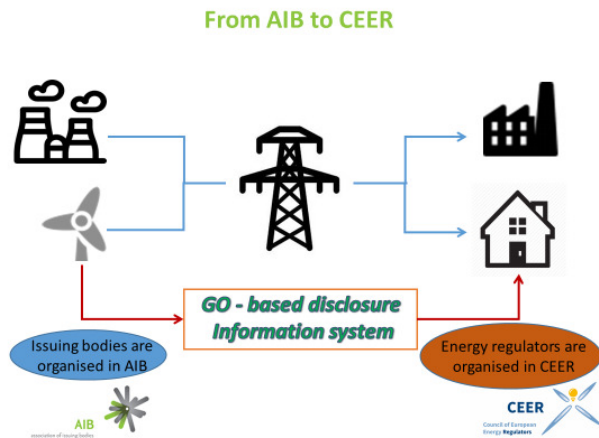

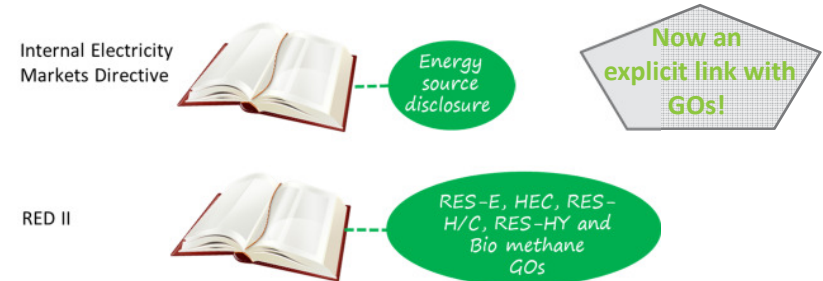
